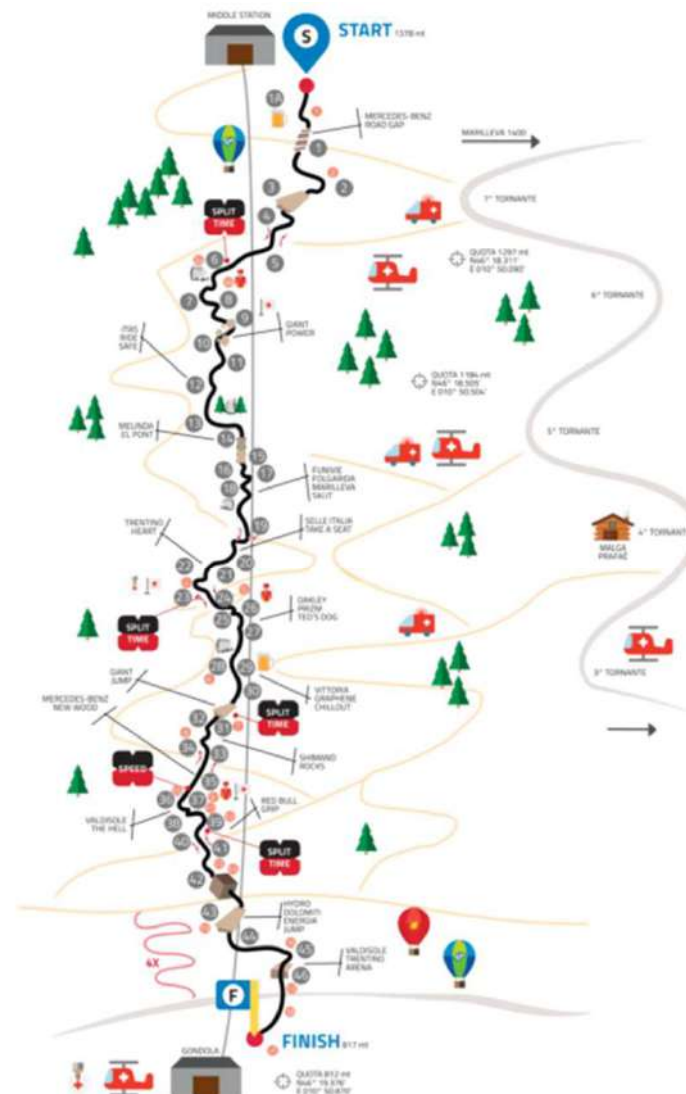

RACE PROCEDURES



○ Transponders

- The transponder is fixed on the bike's front fork at the start (*see picture*).
- Transponders used during the timed training session must be kept by the riders for the qualifying round. These transponders will be distributed at the start.
- During the qualifying round, all transponders are collected at the finish.
- New transponders will be distributed for the finals at the start.
- All riders are responsible for the return of their transponder in the finish area. Any non-returned transponder will be invoiced 100 euros.

○ Equipment

- Due to the Italian national regulation all the riders on the DHI races needs the following protections :
 - ✓ full-face helmet with visor
 - ✓ back protector
 - ✓ long sleeve shirt

RULES REMINDER



○ Cameras

- Allowed only in training
- If a rider would like to be considered to wear a GoPro camera during Qualifying and Finals for the purpose of collecting images for use by television, in addition to signing the GoPro waiver form, the team manager or the rider will need to submit the riders' name directly to the GoPro Ambassador on-site for each event.

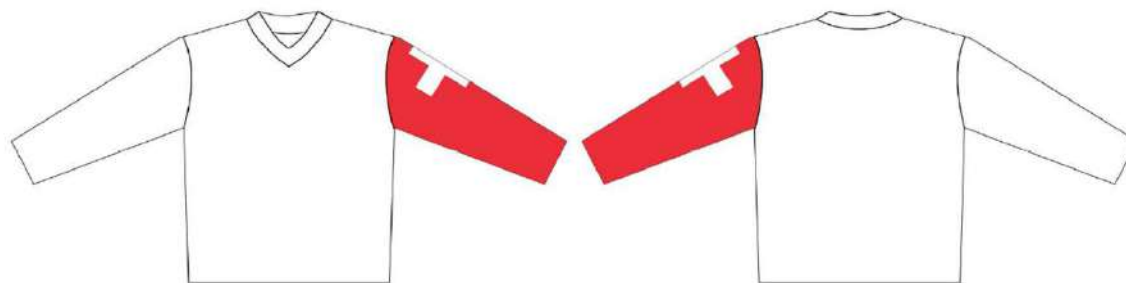



- **Medical resources along the course:**
 - 48 Marshals DHI
 - 2 Emergency nurses
 - 11 team rescuers (PHTC + DAE)
 - 22 Mountain rescuers (Fireman and alpin rescuers)
 - 2 Emergency doctors
 - 4 equipped helicopter landing pads
 - 2 Ambulance vehicles (4x4, SVB and 2 SVA)
 - 1 Ambulance emergency
 - 1 quad of biker & 1 quad mountain rescuers
 - 1 mountain rescue car
 - Direct radio connection to the state control center in the first aid room

GENERAL INFORMATION



- **Operating times** (*average*):
 - Marshall → Injured person 30 sec. to the radio message
 - Rescuers → Injured person from 30 sec to 3 min
 - Mountain rescuers → Injured person from 30 sec to 3 min
 - Emergency doctor -> injured person from 30 sec to 8 min
 - Head of Medical → Injured person 8 min
 - Head of Medical → Injured person 8 min
 - Rescue helicopter → Place of operation from 8 to 14 min

- **Transportation:**
 - Ambulance vehicle → Advanced medical post from 4 to 10 min
 - Rescue helicopter → Hospital 10 min
 - Ambulance vehicle → Hospital 20 min

GENERAL INFORMATION



- **Procedure of an operation:**
 - Marshall radios to head of operations
 - Operations manager sends mountain rescue and nurses to the casualty/marshall
 - Primary care by rescuers and nurses and doctor
 - In the case of seriously injured person, the operation manager are immediately called of rescue helicopter
 - Ambulance transfer to the Advanced Medical post
 - Transport by ambulance or rescue helicopter to the hospital

GENERAL INFORMATION

- **Additional Information**

- 50% of the trial are directly accessible via forest path. Along the last 50% of the trial there are a total of 15 rescuers, so that an injured person can leave the steep forest terrain as quickly as possible.
- Mountain rescue and rescuers or nurses are positioned directly along the route (key points) minor injuries (Abrasion...) are treated by the rescuers and nurses/ doctor just after the rock garden
- In order to maintain more flexibility, to ensure the spectators as well as the medical care of the athletes, 1 additional team will be deployed in the ambulance rescue consisting, 1 paramedic and 1 nurse and 1 doctor

- **Special Material Equipment for Medical Care**
 - Mountain Rescue Service:
 - 3 rescue board is made of carbon fiber
 - 14 spine boards compatible for direct transfer to the rescue helicopter
 - Emergency Doctor
 - Equipment for possible ventilation of patients requiring intensive care
 - Schiller DEFIGARD Touch for monitoring/ reanimation
 - Various emergency medicines
 - suction unit
 - Digital radios

- **Special Material Equipment for Medical Care**
 - Emergency nurse:
 - Medumat for possible ventilation of patients requiring intensive care
 - Philips MRX monitor for monitoring/ reanimation
 - Various emergency medicines
 - Suction unit
 - Digital radios
 - Rescue
 - Equipment for possible ventilation of patients requiring intensive care
 - Every paramedic always has analogic radios - permanent radio connection
 - scoop stretcher, rescue sheet for removal/transfer
