Outfit

- Riders are required to wear the outfit as indicated on the start lists: WCh: World Champion – WCL: World Cup Leader, CCh: Continental Champion (EUR and PAN mandatory) - NCh: National Champion - N: National Outfit
- Official training sessions and interviews made on the venue are considered as part of the official competition and the rider's outfit shall fit to the UCI rules during these sessions, at the exception of the UCI World Cup leader for which a tolerance is applied so that the leader's outfit might not be worn during the training sessions.

Start order

WOMEN ELITE, MEN ELITE

1. The first 8 riders of the UCI cyclo-cross world cup standings published on 11 Dec. 2022 after Dublin (IRL)
2. As per the UCI Cyclo-cross individual rankings published on 13 Dec. 2022
3. Unclassified riders: by nations in rotation

Start procedure

For Men Elite and Women Elite, the rider 9th of the start order will be called first, the first row of the grid being free. 6 minutes before the start the rider ranked 8th of the start order will be called, then the rider ranked 7th and so on. Call-up will be over 2,5 minutes before the start.

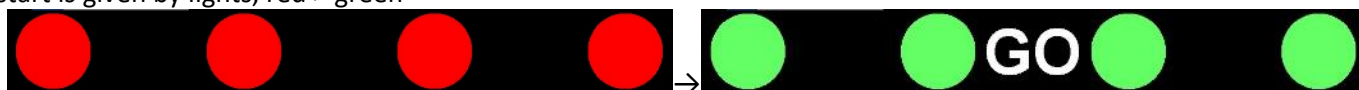
Top 8 riders will have to announce their position to the TV delegate when they arrive in the warming up zone, the 1st rider of the start order choosing 1st, then the 2nd rider of the start order and so on.

**Call-up starts: 8 minutes before the start for Women Elite – 12h52
8 minutes before the start for Men Elite – 14h22**

Please note:

- Starter's countdown: 3 minutes, 2 minutes, 1 minute, 30 seconds
- Riders' assistants on the road between 2 minutes to 1 minute to the start
- Riders causing false start will be relegated to the last position of the gridding during the new call-up
- Riders forcing or pushing to enter the preceding start row will be fined

The start is given by lights, red > green



Transponders return

Volunteers will collect the transponders at the 80% zone during the race and behind the finish line, with riders' assistants.

Please do not return the transponder to any person other than volunteers appointed to that task or UCI timing crew in the finish truck.

Not returned: 150 EUR charged at the end of the season.

Awards ceremony

The top 3 riders of the race will show up to the awards ceremony after their race, plus the top 3 women under 23 of the women race.

Media mixed zone

- There is **no press conference** after the award ceremony
- Riders not attending the ceremony may be interviewed in the Media mixed zone before, during and after the ceremony
- Riders attending the ceremony will be interviewed in the Media mixed zone after the Ceremony

- Top 40 riders for Women Elite and Men Elite

Pit area - boxes allocation

As per the UCI rules article 5.1.036, the boxes are allocated per riders' nationality:

- 1 Separately for each category (Women Elite and Men Elite) on the basis of the last UCI cyclo-cross ranking by nation for the category concerned;
- 2 The allocation of boxes to nations that do not feature in the relevant ranking shall be by drawing lots;
- 3 The president of the commissaires' panel shall prepare per category the number of pits allocated to each nation, taking into account the number of riders. Three boxes maximum are allocated to one nation. Nations with a small number of riders are grouped in the same box;
- 4 The national team managers select their preferred boxes in the order determined by points 1 and 2. Any nation that is allocated 2 or 3 boxes must choose the numbers of these boxes back to back;

One zone is reserved for Team Managers. Photographers and TV crew for interviews are allowed in this zone, not in the boxes.

Antidoping controls

- Doping Controls (if any) will be conducted under the 2022 Anti-Doping Rules of the UCI and the International Testing Agency (ITA) procedures and instructions.
- The riders selected for the controls will be notified by a chaperone; the notified rider shall remain within sight of the chaperone at all times from the moment of in-person notification until the completion of the sample collection procedure. Team officials should not prevent the chaperone to continuously observe the rider. If the award ceremony takes place immediately after the event, a rider needing to go to the award ceremony will be escorted first to the award ceremony area, then to the press conference and finally to the Doping Control Station (DCS).
- Notification by the chaperone will only be made orally. Not signing the notification form upon the oral notification does not excuse the Rider from not attending the DCS. The written notification will be finalized with the Doping Control Officer at the DCS.
- Each rider notified of his selection for testing must report immediately to the doping control station after finishing the race, save for justified reasons that could cause a delay such as participation in a medal ceremony, fulfilments of media commitment or receiving necessary medical treatment (non exhaustive list).
- Riders must report to the DCS with their current license; but if it has no photograph, another I.D. with a photo must be presented.
- In order to limit the number of persons at the DCS, it is recommended that the Rider presents him or herself alone, but at most he may be accompanied by only one person of his choice.
- Riders must wear a mask to come to the DCS and disinfect their hands when entering.
- Any changes related to the localization of the riders participating in the race (hotel name, address and phone numbers) must be communicated to the UCI as soon as possible.
